FAQ's

Q For what type of events do I need a Log Book?

A Rallies and Rallysprints conducted under an AMSAG permit.

Q What is the cost for a Log Book?

A AMSAG do not charge for a Log Book.

Q Do I have to renew my Log Book annually?

A No. There is no renewal required until the book is filled with event details.

Q How do I apply for a Log Book?

A Make a booking to have the vehicle inspected by an AMSAG Authorised Scrutineer. Present this completed application form to the Scrutineer. If the vehicle is found to be satisfactory, the scrutineer will issue a new Log Book. To register your new Log Book, the Scrutineer will fax both the completed scrutineering inspection report and this form to AMSAG on 02 8078 3808.

Q When do I need my Log Book?

A You must present your Log Book for Scrutineering for each event. You may also be asked to produce it at an event by the Chief Scrutineer, so always take it with you to events.

Q What if I sell my car?

A Complete a Log Book Amendment Form (available on the AMSAG website at www.amsag.com.au/members) – including your signature as the old owner and the signature of the new owner – and forward it to the AMSAG Secretary. The contact details are on the AMSAG website at www.amsag.com.au/contact.

Q Do I need to reapply for a Log Book if I change the specification of my car?

A No. Just complete a Log Book Amendment Form (available on the AMSAG website at www.amsag.com.au/members) – advising only those details that have changed – paint colour, engine capacity, rego number, etc – and forward it to the AMSAG Secretary.
