ARTICLE 1 - SERIES PERSONNEL

1.1 Series Coordinator

- (a) Liaise with competitors.
- (b) Maintain the points register
- (c) Receive applications and determine driver eligibility

ARTICLE 2 - SERIES STRUCTURE

2.1 Series Structure

- a) The Series shall comprise of four Rounds:
- b) The Series Coordinator reserves the right to either cancel or amend any Rounds of the Series.
- c) All events will be included in the series point score. The competitor with the highest aggregate point's accumulation will be awarded the Rookie Series.
- d) There will be a separate Drivers point score, and a separate Navigators point score.

2.2 Qualifying Events

The four events that comprise the 2011 Rookie Series are:

July 30	Batemans Bay
October 22	Jenolan

ARTICLE 3 - REGISTRATION

- 3.1 a) Competitors must make application to compete in the Series by completing the registration form. The registration form must be lodged with the Series Coordinator prior to the start of the first Round in which the competitor wishes to score points. - b) Registration for the series is FREE

ARTICLE 4 - ELIGIBILITY

4.1 Drivers Requirements

- a) To be eligible for the Rookie Series drivers will need to be members of AMSAG and have competed in not more than 5 rallies in total as a driver.
- b) The Series Co-ordinator has final determination with regard to driver eligibility.

4.2 Navigator Requirements

- a) To be eligible for the AMSAG Rookie Series navigators will need to be members of AMSAG and have competed in not more than 5 rallies in total as a navigator.
- b) The Series Coordinator has final determination with regard to navigator eligibility.

4.3 Registered Driver / Ineligible Navigators

- a) A registered driver teamed with an ineligible or unregistered navigator will score points towards to Rookie Series.

4.4 Ineligible Drivers / Registered Navigators

- a) A registered navigator can only score rookie series points when competing with an eligible and registered driver.

4.5 Vehicles

- a) To be eligible for Rookie Series point's competitors must use a normally aspirated 2 Wheel Drive vehicle, complying with AMSAG class and safety regulations.

ARTICLE 5 – SERIES SIGNAGE

Competitors are obliged to display any series signage or series sponsorship decals on competing vehicles in all rounds of the series if such signage is provided to competitors.

ARTICLE 6 - POINTS

6.1 Points will be allocated at each round of the series on the following basis:

2 nd	25 pts
3 rd	22 pts
4 th	20 pts
5 th	18 pts
6 th	16 pts
7 th	14 pts
8 th	13 pts
9 th	12 pts
10 th	11 pts

Trophies will be awarded at each round of the series for the following positions, based on outright event classification:

1st Rookie Driver / Navigator

2nd Rookie Driver / Navigator

3rd Rookie Driver / Navigator

7.2 Series Awards

1st Rookie Driver - Trophy, Champions Rally Jacket,

2nd Rookie Driver - Trophy, Runners-Up Rally Jacket.

3rd Rookie Driver - Trophy

1st Rookie Navigator - Trophy, Champions Rally Jacket

2nd Rookie Navigator - Trophy, Runners-Up Rally Jacket

3rd Rookie Navigator – Trophy
