SERVICE INSTRUCTIONS

W H &S ADVICE FOR COMPETITORS AND SERVICE CREWS

The Organisers wish to remind you that WorkCover NSW legislation deems a Rally Service Park to be a NSW Workplace. Therefore, all of the workplace and WH&S practices that we observe every day in our regular working environment must also be observed and practiced at all times within the Service Park.

All personnel are asked to assess the risks associated with any practice that they are involved with, and take action to minimise the potential injury to themselves and any other personnel.

You have a Duty of Care for the health and safety of those people who might be affected by the activities of your team whilst at the rally. These people may include the members of your competing crew, service crew, spectators and the general public. You may be held liable for the damage to property or injury to personnel should suitable assessment and risk minimisation practices not be followed.

Some examples of risks might be:

- The use of electrical power. High voltage cords and appliances should have a current safety inspection tag, and be used with a tagged safety switch.
- When using jacks or jack stands, use equipment that is suitable for the job, and ensure that the vehicle is at all times properly secured. Getting underneath a vehicle that is only supported by a jack is serious risk, and should never be attempted.
- Re-fuelling may be conducted within your own work environment; however, a suitable and approved fire extinguisher should be nearby while refuelling. It is recommended that this extinguisher be manned during the re-fuelling operation. A notice of the danger of the refuelling activity – from mobile phones, heat, cigarettes and other ignition sources – should be erected to warn all personnel not involved with the activity to stay well away.
- To minimise the risk of damage to the environment, a liquid proof ground cover must be beneath the car during all servicing and re-fuelling operations. Be prepared to mop up any liquid spills immediately to avoid contamination of the ground, and report any such contamination to the attending official or Rally Control without delay.
- Personal Safety Clothing should be worn by all personnel to minimise risk or injury. This may involve clothing with long sleeves, fire proof materials, gloves, ear protection and/or safety goggles/glasses.
- Due to the hazards that can be associated to smoking, including the ignition of flammable liquids and gases within the service park, smoking by all persons within the service park is banned during the entire event.

You should consider the risk in all situations, and ensure that you manage all of your activities at the event and be prepared to demonstrate that you have considered these risks and put the appropriate safety measures in place.

DIRECTIONS FROM BEGA TO BOYDTOWN

From the Bega Showground entrance turn right to T junction, TR at T junction (Tathra Road)

1.20	S.O. at roundabout (Hospital)
3.81	T.R Follow main Road signpost; Kerrisons Lane
5.90	T L Princes Highway Eden
28.87	T R Signpost Princes Highway Eden
35.45	S O Through Roundabout
35.70	T R Signpost Princes Highway Eden
48.39	Caution Rally traffic entering onto highway from right

Continue on into Eden. TR at Roundabout, signpost Orbost
Follow the Highway for approx. 7.5ks then T L into Boydtown signpost Boydtown Road
Approx. 700 m down this road TL into Service Park

RULES OF THE SERVICE PARK

Please follow these rules within the Service Park

- Drive at walking speed
- Use the garbage bins provided for all litter
- Use a tarp or plastic sheet under the vehicle to protect area from spills
- **Refuelling may only be done in designated areas**
- No smoking within the service park or refuel areas
- Report any incidents to the Officials at the Service Park Control
- NO Alcohol permitted in Service Park

REMOTE REFUEL 1 – Kallack Road

- **NO** service Crew allowed at remote refuel 1 on Sunday morning
- **Rally Crew only to refuel car at remote refuel**
- Crews to supply labelled fuel cans (with fuel in them) to Boydtown designated refuel area **before** car 1 leaves Boydtown on Sunday
- The cans will be taken to the remote refuel area by Safety Officers and returned back to Boydtown
- Don't forget to collect your fuel can from Boydtown

Remote Refuel 2 directions – emergency refuel if required

- From Boydtown service area head towards the Princes Highway turn left onto Highway
- Continue down highway for several km, Road sign Edrom Rd on left continue SO
- Turn Right at T Junction Princes Highway and Imlay Rd
- Remote refuel is on RHS in Imlay Rd just near this intersection
- Cars will be approaching from the South on Highway and turning left onto Imlay Road
- Service Crew are permitted here

RECOVERY INFORMATION

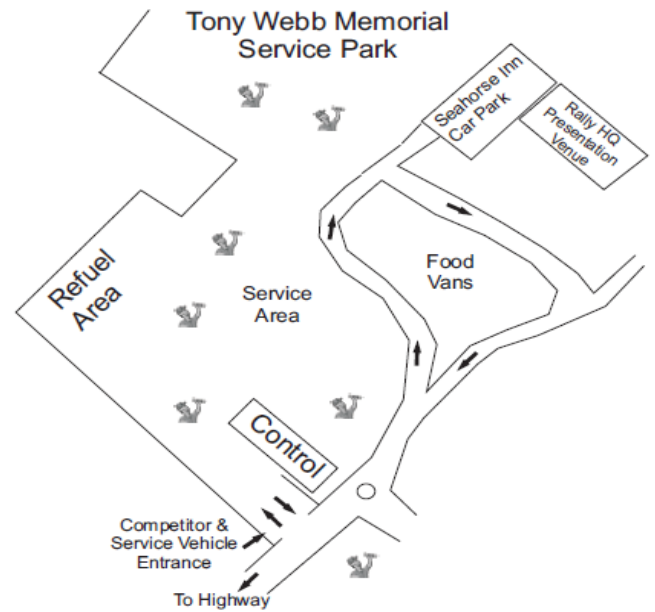
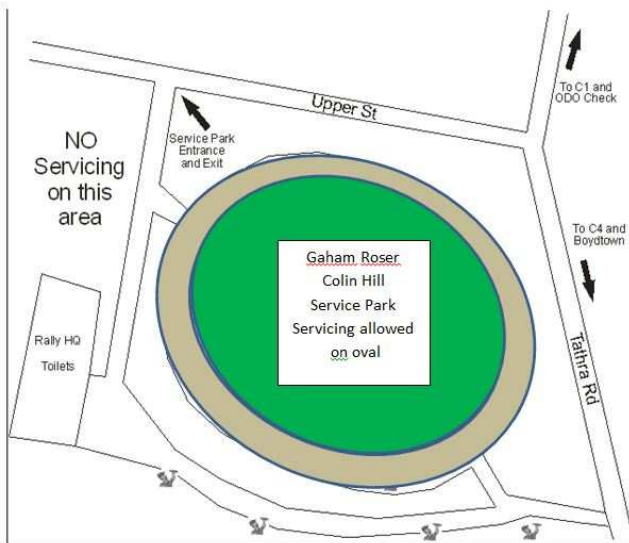
Please note that no service crew is to drive on any competitive stage of the rally without permission from Rally Control.

Competing vehicles will traverse all stages only once. Recovery may only be undertaken after the passage of the sweep vehicle.

Although a stage has been reopened, please drive in the direction of the stage whenever possible, as there may be other traffic on the stage, to recover vehicles or clean up.
